You should also have the academic skills to study at a Diploma level and preferably should have completed a Certificate 4 level course (or equivalent) before you enrol.

Foundation Coaching Diploma – Diploma of Sport (Coaching) & Equine Sports Diploma – Diploma of Sport

Entry requirement: Evidence that you are able to work safely within the horse industry. This can be shown through competition results, certificates, work references in a professional equine establishment. They should show at a minimum you are able to:

- work safely in the horse industry;
 - handle horses safely;
 - provide basic care of horses;
 - perform daily tasks required within the horse industry;
 - apply knowledge of horse behaviour;
 - participate in workplace communications;
- any additional equine skills.

Introductory Coaching Diploma - aligned with Equestrian Australia

- Entry requirements to be completed prior to commencing specific coaching units that have been aligned to EA.
 - EA Introductory Horse Management Certificate; and
 - EA Introductory Riding/Personal Skills

Equestrian Coaching Diploma – Diploma of Sport (Equestrian Coaching) – aligned with Equestrian Australia

- Students must hold the following EA certificates to enrol
 - EA Level 1 Horse Management
 - EA Level 1 Riding/Personal Skills

- Practical assessments
 - Option 1 - Practical Training & Assessment Workshop - Attend a workshop at our Caboolture QLD venue (fees apply)
 - Option 2 - Video Submission - Submit your Practical or Third Party Report via video submission using the facilities and horses you have access to already (Conditions apply)
 - Option 3 – In person with an Approved Equine Industry Expert (pre-approval & conditions apply)
