- Dressage or Competition tests/exams

You will need access to:

- Horse and rider for instructing units.
- Access to a qualified coach (observation of coaching).
- Access to a horse float for loading.
- Work in a Community Coaching Role – total 30 hours.

- Australian Sports Commission Online Community Coaching course (this co-requisite is delivered at no cost)
