Course Summary

This course is a fast track method for those who are already operating a business and have at least 100 hours of teaching/instructor experience. This Statement of Attainment qualification includes teaching people the basics so they can enjoy their recreational horse riding safely.

Entry requirement:

- be fit and healthy enough to meet the practical requirements of this course.
- evidence at least 100 hours teaching horse riding;
- be at least eighteen (18) years of age to commence this course;
- recommend that you have completed equivalent to year 10 (Queensland education)
- this course is delivered in English, so you should be able to read, write, listen and speak the English language.

For entry into the Recreation Horse Riding Instructor Statement of Attainment you are required to evidence a minimum of 100 hours experience as a horse riding Instructor. This can be evidenced in the following ways that relate to instructing/coaching horse riding:

Acceptable Evidence Options

- Certificates relating to Equines (instructing)
- Certificate of Participation (in any equine related instructor clinics or events)
- Letter from an employer or equine business you volunteer/work at, identifying your instructor experience and skills with equines (on business letterhead and including an ABN, with original signature)

Co-Requisite

- St Johns First Aid (or equivalent to be completed with an external provider)
- Australian Sports Commission Online Community Coaching course (this co-requisite is delivered at no cost)

You will need access to:

- at least 4 riders and horses (including tack and PPE)
- A contained horse handling environment which must include:
 - Small fenced enclosures
 - Large fenced enclosures
 - Areas containing doorways and gates
- A fenced horse riding arena with a safe surface for the horse riding exercises.

Course Duration: Full Time Study: 10 weeks

Part Time Study: 20 weeks

Course Delivery: Online only - Theory delivered through our Student Portal - Practical assessments submitted by video
