Course Duration:

Full Time Study: 62 weeks

Entry Requirement: This course does have an entry requirement (due to the high risk nature of the equine industry) of 5 specified horse care units. If you have substantial horse experience or horse related certificates, they could be used as Acceptable Evidence Options:

- Certificates relating to Equines (husbandry, training, instructing etc)
- Certificate of Participation (in any equine related clinics or events)

Course Costs

Co-contribution of \$10 (for Year 12 graduates in the first 12 months post-graduation from a Queensland school).

Co-contribution of \$50 (for students who hold a Centrelink concession card & are no longer in school)

Co-contribution of \$100 (for students who do not have a Centrelink concession card & are no longer in school)
