Entry Requirement. To be accepted into this course, you should be:

1. fit and healthy enough to meet the practical requirements of this course;
2. have at least 100 hours of trail riding experience which needs to be evidenced;
3. at least eighteen (18) years of age;
4. able to ride out on trail in walk, trot and canter and jump small obstacles;
5. previous qualification or extensive experience with horses which needs to be evidenced.

Acceptable Evidence Options

- Certificates relating to Equines (husbandry, training, instructing etc).
- Certificate of Participation (in any equine related clinics or events).
- Letter from an employer identifying your experience and instructor skills with equines.
- Dressage or Competition tests/exams.

You will need access to:

- Horse trail riding environment
- Trail Rides – Access to a minimum of 4 riders & horses (not including yourself)
- Instruction Sessions – Access to minimum of 3 handlers and horses.

Co-Requisite

- St Johns First Aid (or equivalent to be completed with an external provider)
- Australian Sports Commission Online Community Coaching course (this co-requisite is delivered at no cost)
